The valley of Kashmir in the state of Jammu and Kashmir has been subject to a territory dispute since the end of British Rule in India in 1947.

Some figures include:

- more than 100,000 civilians killed,
- more than 10,000 women raped,
- more than 25,000 women widowed,
- more than 110,000 children orphaned,
- and more than 125,000 houses and shops burned.

Currently in India-administered Kashmir, human rights violations are worsening every day including extra judicial killings, gang rapes, mass graves, destruction of property, and disappearances.

The current uprising started on July 8<sup>th</sup> 2016 when Indian security forces killed Burhan Wani, an activist and commander of one of the largest indigenous militant groups. Since then at least 86 people have died and more than 6,000 have been injured. In addition, more than 1.7 million pellets have been fired and at least 300 of the total injured lost one or both eyes from these high velocity pellet guns.

Other human rights violations include thousands of arrests and 24-hour curfews, the longest lasting more than 80 days. Our talk show “Human Rights Violations in Kashmir” features three guests.

- ▶ Ali Raza Syed is from Azad, Kashmir and is the Chairman of the Kashmir Council-EU, and has been based in Brussels since 1982. He has lobbied in European parliament and other institutions for the right of the people of Kashmir for over 15 years.

We are very fortunate that these guests were able to provide insight on Kashmir human rights violations and share personal stories especially since activists from the Kashmir valley and parts of India, who were invited to be guests on our show, were obtained at the last minute in India.
