### Concept

In september 2016 we startet our sparkling project “Speak out – Refugees produce television” which brings a new perspective in the Media! A TV-channel made by and with Newcomers.

Our first Arabic live Talk-show was the start to connect the Refugees with society, followed by the German live talk with newcomers about Democracy and Religion in countries of origin. The Talk-Show "Dance for your live" is about arts and culture with people of different origins. The program "Violantation of human rights - the Kashmir-Conflict" is a guest-production realised by Speak-out mediateam.

► Creation of a TV-Talkshow: Reasons to leave the home country

→ As a presenter or guest you will be able to shape the style of a TV-show. Asking the right questions about the “reason to flee” is just a secret of successful conversation with newcomers. The workshop focuses on the role of the moderator and the art of interview.

► Photoexposition: Identity and reasons of leaving the home countries

→ Showing pictures and videos of newcomers and migrants, giving the chance for the participants to play a game of identity in this way. The method shows how many people judge and make conclusions about others without knowing them, like some stereotypes in the society about Newcomers.

► Empowerment of women

→ After fleeing from their home country, a new start of life. Talking about women's rights and sharing some stories of women who get empowered in this crucial time. Reflection of our stories through different games.
